

Georgia's Community Solar projects & The Benefits

- **Right now, Georgia Power Customers do not have access to solar saving!**
This program will provide badly needed saving to Community Solar subscribers
 - Residential Customers, many of whom are living below the poverty line
 - Renters and property owners, people without suitable roofs for solar panels,
 - Tax-exempt entities: Churches, Schools, Public entities who have a duty to provide the cheapest most reliable form of energy to their communities
 - Businesses
- **Georgia's 6 MW Community Solar projects**
 - Takes up between 25-30 Acres
 - Will provide energy to the Distribution Grid
 - These generation facilities are spread throughout Georgia distributing the benefits
 - Distributed Generation provides resiliency to the grid statewide
- **Private Investment will finance additional (clean) energy resources, instead of ratepayers**
 - Solar provides energy during peak hours when utilities need it the most!
 - Needed investment in a time when Georgia is facing a severe energy deficit
 - Massive Investment will inject billions of economic development dollars into Georgia's economy
 - Construction of Facilities
 - Jobs
 - Local & Domestic Supply
 - Operation of Facilities
 - Jobs in Operation and Maintenance
 - Lease payment to rural landowners
 - Property taxes to local governments

Community Solar– The Exchange

Counterparties:

- Georgia Power Company (GPC)
- Solar Company
- Ratepayer / Customer

Georgia Power Customers pay nothing for

- Additional grid generation
- Energy resiliency
- Instant Savings

GPC still sends Bill to Customer for their usage

- Bill Shows a Community Solar Credit
- Customer saves between 10 – 20 %
